\$17,600,000	I-70 and 32nd Ave. reconfiguration	1-70 and 32nd Ave.
\$21,600,000	I-70 and Kipling reconfiguration	I-70 and Kipling
\$8,480,000	Wadsworth widening from 36th to 46th	Wads from 36th to 46th
